

High School Faith Formation Information

- **Wednesday Youth Group:** The focus of the Youth Group is on discussion of topics important to high schoolers as they grow in their faith. If you want to talk about how faith interacts and affects your daily life, this is the group for you. It meets about three Wednesdays a month at 4:15 or 6:30PM.
- **NEW! Sunday Service Group:** This group will focus on doing service projects when they meet two Sundays per month from 6:00-7:30 PM. There will always be food as part of each gathering, as well as service and a chance to chat and socialize. No need to pre-register. Sign up when you come!
- **Club 3:16:** After school, starting at 3:16 we will have open Gym, a study area, and snacks each Wednesday. In addition, we will have a variety of fun activities like movies and open Youth Room, as well as service opportunities, until 4:15 classes begin. No registration needed! Just have your child head straight to St. Mary's to be part of Club 3:16!
- **Youth Room:** St. Mary's has a Youth Room, where the Youth Group meets each week. Youth will have a chance to play games, hang out with friends, or work on homework, instead of regular Youth Group meetings some nights.
- **Workcamp:** Looking for an experience that can change your life? Spend a week learning about yourself, growing in faith, and helping a family in need. This is a unique experience to share with the many new friends you will meet on the trip.
