Action: Support full funding of the Homes4All 2020 Legislative Agenda

Mental Health Services

Action: Support greater access to high quality health care services.

Preventing Gun Violence

Action: Supporting Red Flag Legislation (allows family members or law enforcement personnel to petition court to prohibit firearm possession for people who are a danger to self or others)

Social Justice Rationale: "Gun violence is sometimes perpetrated by people struggling with mental illness, depression, or addiction, Minnesota must make a serious commitment to provide health services and support to those who are facing such challenges, as well as to their families and caregivers.
