

FUNERAL LUNCHEONS IN ST. JOSEPH'S ROOM

St. Mary of the Lake parishioners are happy to assist your family with hosting hospitality after a funeral liturgy. Luncheons are held in St. Joseph's Room at the church. We can accommodate **up to 50 guests** comfortably. Our kitchen facilities at the church are very limited, so we are unable to serve hot foods or foods that must be refrigerated (i.e. salads, etc.)

We are happy to serve finger foods but are not able to serve foods that require a fork. Suggestions include: meat and cheese trays, buns, croissants, roll-ups, subs, pickles, vegetable trays, cookies, bars, muffins, munchies such as chips, pretzels, nuts, and candy.

St. Mary's provides:

- A hospitality team for setup, serving, cleanup
- Coffee, cream and sugar, lemonade and water
- Paper plates and cups, napkins
- Serving trays, bowls, utensils for serving

Family provides:

- All food. To assure food safety, it is preferred that food be delivered by a vendor/caterer with the exception of desserts which may be homemade. Prepared trays from Cub, Costco or Sam's are acceptable also.
- Beverage alternative to coffee, lemonade, and water, if desired
- If possible, empty containers with covers for leftovers
