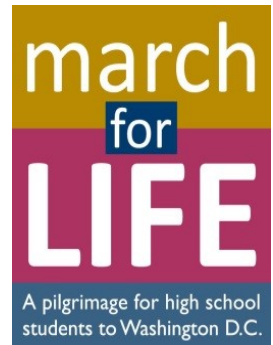

## Pilgrim and Parent Information



**Dates:** Tuesday, January 18– Sunday, January 23, 2022

### Pilgrimage

Please be aware that this is a pilgrimage for life and will involve prayer, sacrifice and discomfort. It is not a tour group or vacation. There will be much time for prayer, mass, reflection and sharing. The schedule will be full. There will be very little free time. There will be some time for visiting museums, but this is not the focus of the trip. Over the years, many lives have been transformed through this pilgrimage.

### Cell Phones

As part of the Culture and Dignity of Life this trip promotes, cell phones may be brought but may not be used except as a camera or during explicitly specified times. Cell phones will be immediately impounded accordingly.

### Departure

The busses will be available for loading at 4pm. **Please do not arrive before 4:00pm.** Mass will begin at 5:15 pm and we will leave immediately thereafter. Families and friends are all very welcome to join us for mass.

### Return

We will arrive in St. Paul sometime between 4-6pm on January 23. We cannot know the exact time of our return. Groups should set up a phone tree to alert those who need to know of our arrival time as we near the cities.
