

FUNERAL LUNCHEONS IN ST. JOSEPH'S ROOM

St. Mary of the Lake parishioners are happy to assist your family with hosting hospitality after a funeral liturgy. Luncheons are held in St. Joseph's Room at the church. We can accommodate **up to 70 guests** comfortably. Our kitchen facilities at the church are very limited, so **we are unable to serve hot foods.**

We are happy to serve meat and cheese trays, buns, croissants, roll-ups, subs, pickles, vegetable and fruit trays, cold salads, cookies, bars, muffins, munchies such as chips, pretzels, nuts and candy.

St. Mary's provides:

- A hospitality team for set up, serving, clean up
- Coffee, cream and sugar, lemonade and water
- Paper plates, cups and napkins, plastic tableware
- Serving trays, bowls, utensils for serving

Family provides:

- All food. To assure food safety, it is preferred that food be delivered by a vendor/caterer with the exception of desserts which may be homemade.
- Prepared trays or salads from Cub, Lunds & Byerlys, Costco or Sam's are acceptable as well
- Beverage alternative to coffee, lemonade and water, if desired
- If possible, empty containers with covers for leftovers
