We give thanks for our good health and the good health of others.

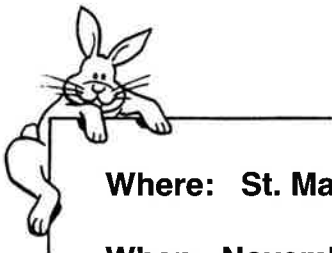
We give thanks for the Grace of Christ in our lives!
